



## Student Guidance Notes

### BSc (HONS) EXERCISE AND SPORT SCIENCE – 85B4

#### Course duration 6 years

#### Introduction:

---

In 2018/19, tuition fees for the above course will be as follows in line with other Undergraduate Degree courses:

- **Home/EU students:** £2312.5 per 30 credits
- **Overseas students:** £3375 per 30 credits

However, as you commenced your course prior to 2018/19 the University will hold your lower fee providing you complete your course in the normal timeframe. Manchester Met will however permit a continuing student **one** additional year of the lower fee if they need to suspend or repeat a year.

We have put together these guidance notes to advise what your fees are likely to be if you are **returning** in 2018/19 and later years to complete your course.

- **Home/EU students:** £1290 per 30 credits
  - **Overseas students:** £1750 per 30 credits

**Q1: I started my course in 2017/18 and suspended my studies until 2018/19. Will I pay fees the lower or higher fee?**

**A1:** Your fees will be the lower fee **providing you return to your course in 2018/19 academic year**. If your return to studies is delayed until a later Academic Year, higher fees will apply. 2018/19 will be classed as your additional year of the lower fee. To remain on the lower fee you will then need to complete the course in the normal timeframe.

---

**Q2: I started my course in 2017/18 and left the course (withdrawn). If I want to come back to the course again what fees will I be charged?**

**A2:** If you **withdraw** from your course, and then decide to return in **2018/19 or later**, you will be charged the new higher tuition fees. You will also need to submit a new application – contact our Course Enquiries team on 0161 247 6969 for more advice on how to apply.

---

**Q3: If I need to repeat all or part of my course in 2018/19, what fees will I pay?**

**A3:** If you repeat units **without** attendance, no tuition fees will be charged. If you need to repeat units **with** attendance, then tuition fees will be charged at the lower rate. 2018/19 will be classed as your additional year either way. To remain on the lower fee you will then need to complete the course in the normal timeframe.

---

**Q4: I commenced my course in 2016/17 then suspended for the full year in 2017/18. I am due to return in 2018/19 what fees will I be charged?**

**A4:** Providing you return in 2018/19 you will be charged the lower fee. 2018/19 will be classed as your additional year. To remain on the lower fee you will then need to complete the course in the normal timeframe.

---

**Q5: I started my course before 2017/18 what fees will I be charged if I need to suspend my studies in 2018/19 or later years.**

**A5:** Your fees will be the lower fee **providing you return to your course in the following academic year and have not already used your additional year**. If your return to studies is delayed until a later Academic Year, higher fees will apply. To remain on the lower fee you will then need to complete the course in the normal timeframe.

---

**Q6: I started my course before 2017/18 what fees will I be charged if I need to repeat my studies in 2018/19 or later years.**

**A6:** Your fees will be the lower fee **providing you return to your course in the following academic year and have not already used your additional year.** If your return to studies is delayed until a later Academic Year, higher fees will apply. To remain on the lower fee you will then need to complete the course in the normal timeframe.

---

**Q7: I started my course before 2017/18, then Suspended in 2016/17 and 2017/18 for the full academic year what fees will I be charged when I return to study in 2018/19 or later years.**

**A7:** Your fees will be the lower fee **providing you return to your course in 2018/19.** If your return to studies is delayed until a later Academic Year, higher fees will apply. To remain on the lower fee you will then need to complete the course in the normal timeframe. 2018/19 will be classed as your additional year of the lower fee.

---

**Q8: I started my course prior to 2017/18 and then suspended my studies for a second time prior to 2018/19. Will I pay fees the lower or higher fee?**

**A8:** Your fees will be the lower fee **providing you return to your course in 2018/19 academic year.** If your return to studies is delayed until a later Academic Year, higher fees will apply. 2018/19 will be classed as your additional year of the lower fee. To remain on the lower fee you will then need to complete the course in the normal timeframe.
